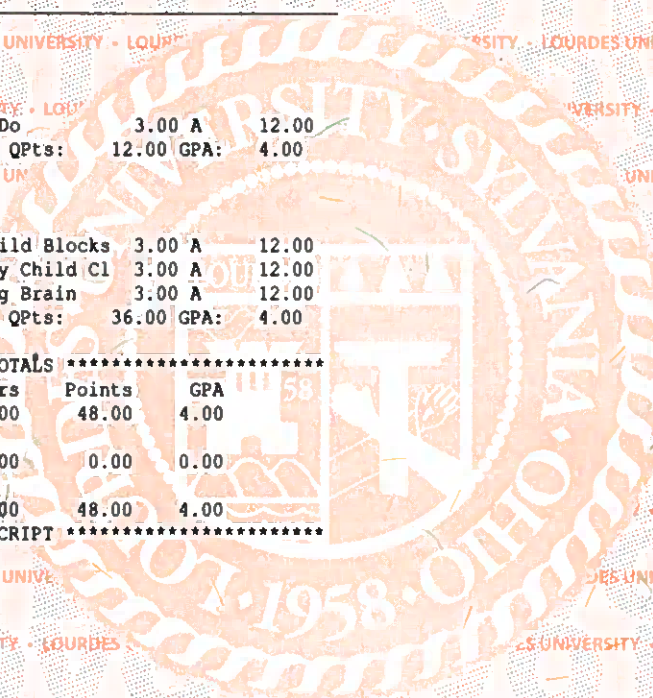

Plus and minus values were added to the grading system for undergraduate courses Winter/Spring 1992; plus and minus values were added to the grading system for graduate courses Fall 2012.

Effective Spring 2012, letter grades (A\*, B\*, C\*, D\*, F\*) were added to the grading system to be issued in place of Satisfactory or Unsatisfactory grades for specific undergraduate courses. These grades have no effect on GPA; credit cannot apply toward graduation.

## Course Levels

Non-degree courses are numbered 1-99; lower division courses are numbered 100-299; upper division courses are numbered 300-499; graduate-level professional development courses are numbered 500-599; graduate-level degree courses are numbered 600 and above.

## Incomplete Grades

Any student who receives the grade of incomplete (I) must complete the required coursework by the end of the following term (excluding summer). Any "I" not completed automatically becomes an "F" (failing) grade and is calculated into the cumulative GPA.

## Repeated Courses

The notation "E" or "I" after a course grade indicate that a course has been repeated. "E" indicates that the course grade has been excluded from the GPA calculation, and "I" indicates that the course grade has been included in the GPA calculation. The most recent grade is calculated into the GPA.

## Dean's List

Any undergraduate student completing 12 or more credit hours in a given semester with a GPA of 3.50 or better earns recognition on the Dean's List for that semester.

## Honor's List

Any undergraduate student completing 6-11 credit hours in a given semester with a GPA of 3.50 or better earns recognition on the Honors List for that semester.

## Graduation Honors

Associate Degrees — Students with a cumulative GPA of 3.50 or better graduate "with Honors."

Bachelor Degrees — Students receiving Bachelor's degrees are eligible for the following designations:

### **summa cum laude**

(Prior to 1993 - Highest Honors)  
Cumulative GPA of 3.90 - 4.00

### **magna cum laude**

(Prior to 1993 - High Honors)  
Cumulative GPA of 3.70 - 3.89

### **cum laude**

(Prior to 1993 - Honors)  
Cumulative GPA of 3.50 - 3.69

## Transfer Credit

The total sum of accepted transfer of credit are indicated at the top of the transcript for degree seeking students. Transfer credit is evaluated individually. Grades from transfer courses are not calculated into the Lourdes GPA.
